Former programs

The Main Street Revitalization - Capital funding program introduces new types of projects that were previously ineligible for funding through Northern Development's programs.

Program overview

The Main Street Revitalization - Capital program provides local governments and Registered First Nations Bands with grant funding to complete strategic public investments in public infrastructure within a community's downtown/main street area.

These projects encourage private sector investment and creates a healthy and economically vibrant area for businesses, residents and tourists.

Project examples

- ▶ Streetscape improvements (sidewalk surfacing, street trees, landscaping, etc.)
- ▶ Lighting improvements
- ▶ Gateway and wayfinding signage
- ▶ Pedestrian and cycle enhancements
- ▶ Street furniture
- ▶ Construction of covered walkway
